DESCRIPTION

The WHO Emergency and the Essential Surgical Care Programme welcomes the members of the WHO Global Initiative for Emergency and Essential Surgical Care (GIEESC), representatives of Member States and other surgical stakeholders to its biennial meeting in Maputo, Mozambique. This meeting will take place in conjunction with the 18th Annual College of Surgeons of East, Central and Southern Africa (COSECSA) Meeting and the Associação Moçambicana de Cirurgia (AMC).

Two years have elapsed since the passage of the resolution WHA68.15 on "strengthening of emergency and essential surgical care and anaesthesia as a component of universal health coverage." During the last GIEESC meeting on December 2015 in Geneva, a roadmap towards implementation of this resolution was drafted. At recent WHA 70, a two-year report was presented and a Decision Point passed calling for continued reporting every 2 years until 2030. A WHO Global Action Plan was initiated.

Please join us in Maputo to hear global public health leaders, policymakers, champions of global surgery, and others discuss the many exciting developments and efforts to bring safe, affordable, and timely surgical care and anaesthesia to all.
