## The Definitive Laparoscopic Skills Enhancement and Assessment Tool

### Program Description

FLS establishes a standard set of didactic information and manual skills serving as a basic curriculum to guide surgical trainees and practicing surgeons in the performance of basic laparoscopic surgery.

- Master the curriculum and skills in this inanimate modality
- Perform laparoscopy more effectively, with greater skill and safety, and with lower complication rates.
- Improve the quality and safety of surgical care delivered to their patients.

### The FLS Program Consists of:

1. FLS Knowledge-Based Curriculum: 13 online modules
2. FLS Testing: Two-part (written and skills) FLS exam to measure your cognitive and technical skills.

#### Proctored FLS Testing:

##### Written Test:

- Timed, 80-question, multiple-choice exam administered online.
- Designed to test the understanding and application of the basic fundamentals of laparoscopy with emphasis on clinical judgment or intraoperative decision making.

##### Manual skills:

- Evaluates laparoscopic skills based on efficiency (speed) and precision (accuracy) of the surgeon's maneuvers.
- Tests 5 non-procedure specific simulation tasks incorporating most of the psychomotor skills necessary for basic laparoscopic surgery.

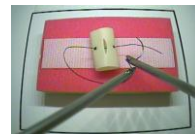

### Eligibility for FLS Testing

- FLS is an universal certification for all surgical specialties that utilize a laparoscope (i.e. general surgery, gynecology, pediatric surgery, urology)
- FLS is eligible for participants of the COSECSA conference, at any level of training or practice (i.e. trainees at membership or fellowship level, junior or senior consultant surgeons)

### Test Prep

- FLS is a rigorous exam requiring thorough preparation to achieve success
- Test takers must carefully review the 13 online modules
- SAGES will hold 3 virtual coaching sessions in October/November to review sample multiple-choice questions and demonstrate best technique for each skills
