COSECSA welcomes applications for Overseas Fellowship from surgeons who live and work outside of the COSECSA region who have been active in COSECSA programs and countries and committed to advancing our training and education missions.

### Application Criteria

1. Experience and commitment to surgery in the COSECSA region
2. Certification or fellowship by a recognized international exit exam in surgery
3. Seven years' experience as a consultant (attending) surgeon

### Fees

Application fee is US\$ 500 and annual subscription fee is \$120.

### How to apply

**Step 1** - Complete the online Overseas Fellow Application Form. In order to complete this form you will be required to upload:

- a) A short CV
- b) A passport-style photo
- c) Two references from COSECSA Fellows

Your application will then be taken to the next Council meeting for discussion and ratification, and you will be notified of their decision via email.

### New Overseas Fellows will

- Receive a COSECSA a certificate
- Be able to use the post-nominal FCS (ECSA).
- Be added to the members' section of the COSECSA website
- Be eligible to apply to be a COSECSA examiner for FCS or MCS
- Be eligible for reduced congress fees
- Receive a regular COSECSA newsletter
